ORDER:

In tune with Tribal Empowerment Policy, 2010-2015 and also in compliance to the (9) Point Program for Tribal Development announced by Hon'ble Chief Minister and as part of the Sunnamvarigudem Declaration articulated by Hon'ble Chief Minister on 8-8-2012, the Tribal Welfare Department has proposed to strengthen infrastructure such as buildings for Residential Junior Colleges with a long term objective of ensuring quality education among STs in the state.

2. The Tribal Welfare Department is running Residential Junior Colleges with the objective of providing better educational facilities to the ST students to provide higher education

3. with a view to provide permanent buildings to certain Residential Junior Colleges, proposals were placed before the Nodal Agency for TSP in its 4th meeting held on 2.12.2013. The Nodal Agency for TSP, after thorough deliberations, has agreed and recommended for construction of buildings for (3) Residential Junior Colleges, vide reference 7th read above. The State Council for the development of SCs and STs also approved the same vide reference 8th read above.

4. After careful examination and keeping in view the decision of the State Council, Administrative Sanction is hereby accorded for Construction of buildings for (3) Residential Junior Colleges, as shown in Annexure-I appended, with an estimated cost of Rs.3.00 Cr. under TSP 2013-14 Scheme of **construction of Residential Junior Colleges in RIAD areas**. Adequate budget provision of Rs. 2.00 Cr. has already been made available under BE 13-14.

5. The expenditure towards construction of the said buildings shall be debited to the following head of account.

6. The Commissioner, Tribal Welfare and Engineer-in-Chief, TW shall take further necessary action and execute the construction of the said Residential Junior Colleges in a time bound manner during the current financial year through the Tribal Welfare Engineering Department.

7. Since this item has been approved by the State Council for the Development of STs and SCs vide reference 8th read above and as per para (5) of the G.O. 4th read above, this order does not require the concurrence of the Finance Department.
