ORDER :

The Tribal Welfare Department is running Ashram Schools with the objective of providing better educational facilities to the ST students. The Government have also reserved all the posts of teachers in Scheduled Area 100% in favor of local STs and because of this there has been a grounding need to make ST teachers available in adequate numbers in tribal areas. In orders to ensure adequate number of ST teachers available in tribal areas, Government have sanctioned (1) B.Ed College at Utnoor, Adilabad district and (2) D.Ed Colleges at BhadrachalamKhammam district & Rampachodavaram East Godavari districts.

2. In tune with Tribal Empowerment Policy, 2010-2015 and also in compliance to the 9-point Program for Tribal Development announced by Honorable Chief Minister and as part of the Sunnamvarigudem Declaration articulated by Honorable Chief Minister on 8-8-2012, the Tribal Welfare Department has proposed to strengthen these institutions with required permanent accommodation for both college and hostels with a long term objective of ensuring quality education among STs in the State.

3. The Nodal Agency for TSP in its meeting held on 13.05.2013, after thorough deliberations, has agreed and recommended for construction of College & hostel building (1) B.Ed College and (2) D.Ed Colleges. The State Council for Development of SCs & STs in its meeting held on 21.05.2013 has approved the proposal of Nodal agency.

4. After careful examination of the proposal and keeping in view the decision of the State Council, Administrative Sanction is hereby accorded for construction of College & hostel building (1) B.Ed College and (2) D.Ed Colleges, as shown in Annexure-I and appended to G.O. at an estimate cost of Rs.7.50 Crores under TSP 2013-14. Adequate budget provision of Rs. 160.00 Crores has been already made available under BE 2013-14.

5. The Commissioner, Tribal Welfare and Engineer-in-Chief, TW shall take further necessary action and execute the construction of the said B.Ed and D.Ed College and hostel buildings in a time bound manner during the current financial year through the Tribal Welfare Engineering Department.

6. The expenditure towards construction of the College & hostel building said B.Ed and D.Ed College buildings shall be debited to the following head of account.

4225	- Capital outlay on Welfare of SCs, STs and OBCs
02	- Welfare of STs
MH 277	- Education
GH 11	- Normal State Plan
SH (75)	- Buildings for School Complexes
